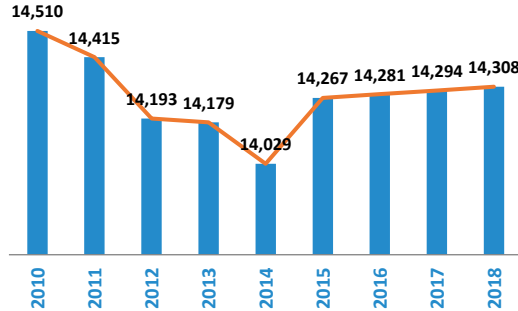


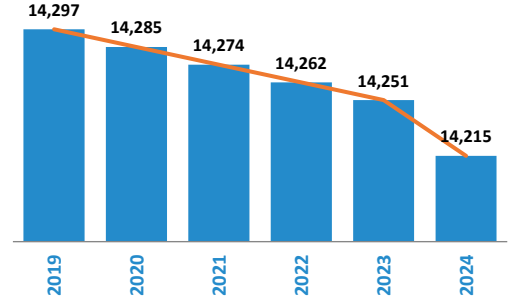
## POPULATION

### POPULATION PROJECTIONS

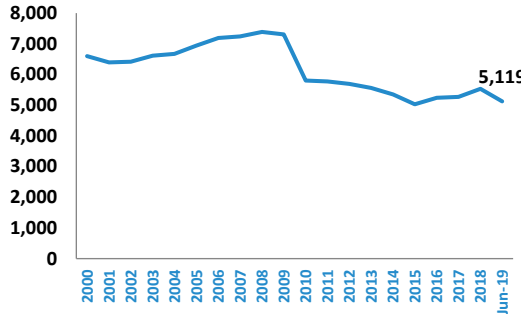

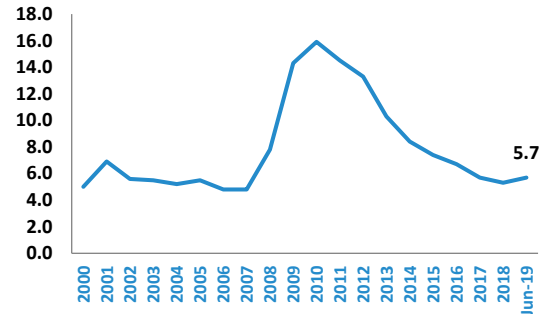
## LABOR

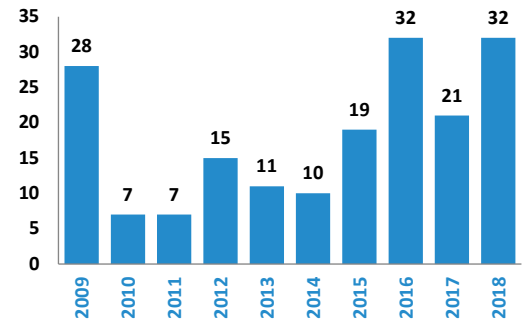
## HOUSING

### HOUSING PERMITS

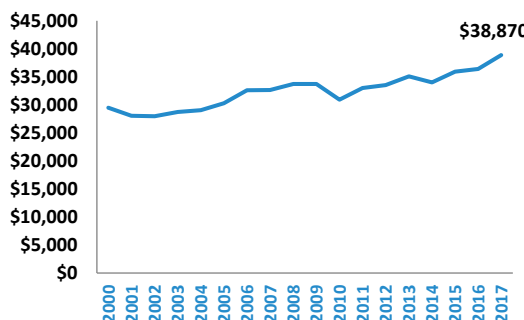

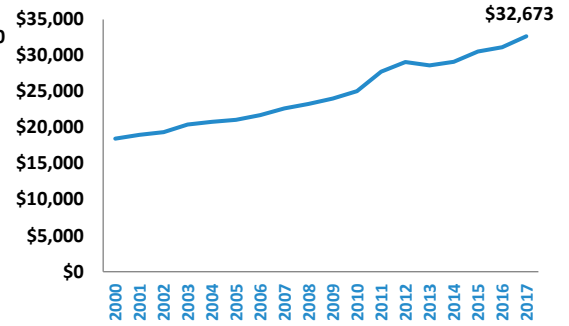
## INCOME
