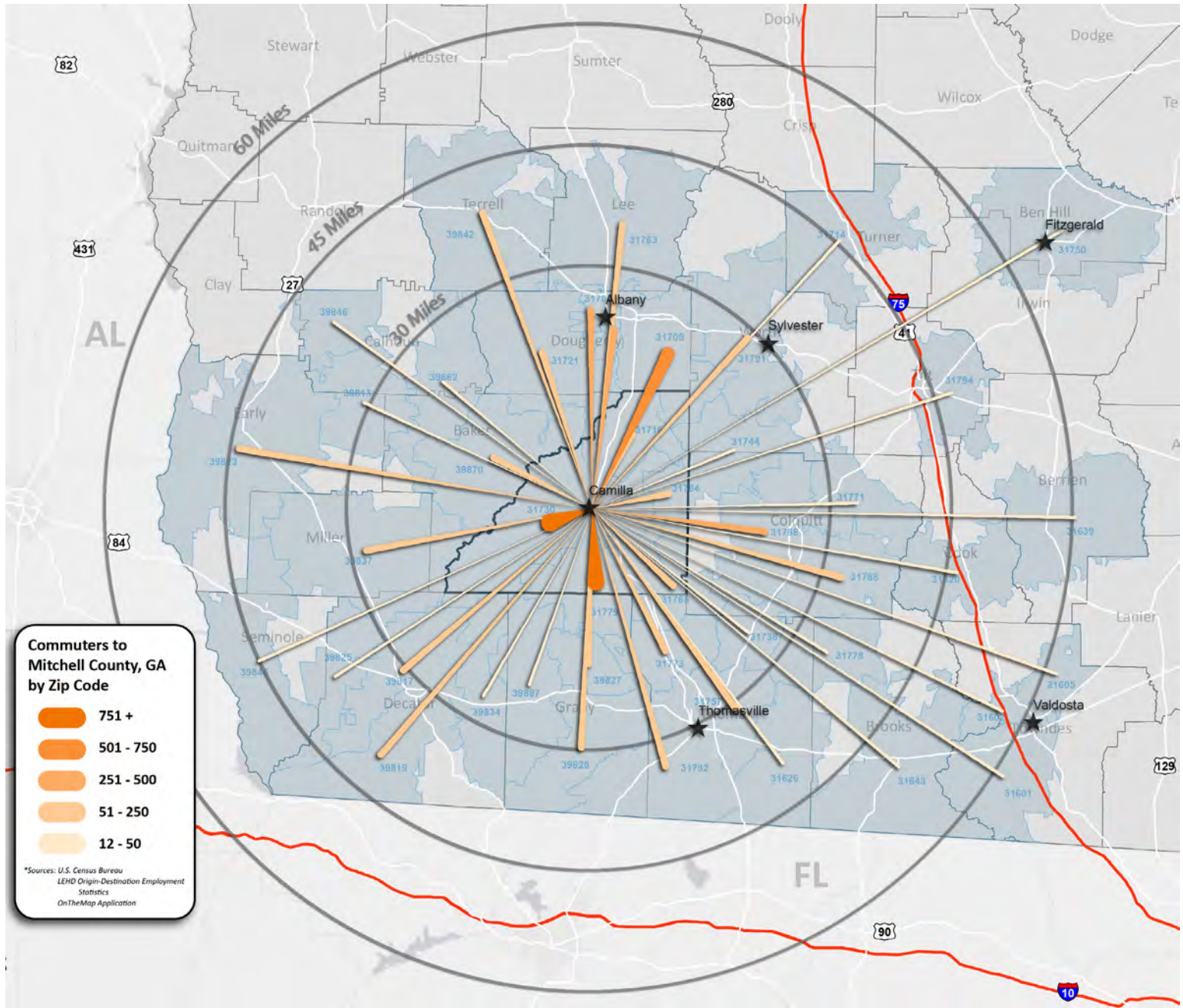

# Introduction & Methodology

The purpose of this Laborshed Analysis is to report on the availability and characteristics of workers in the vicinity of Mitchell County, Georgia. The Mitchell County Laborshed Region was defined according to the U.S. Census Bureau OnTheMap database, combining zip code tabulation areas (ZTCAs) in which the labor force commuting to Mitchell County is greater than 0.1%. In this report, the labor force statistics are provided for Mitchell County, the defined Laborshed Region, and 30-mile, 45-mile, and 60-mile radii surrounding Camilla, Georgia. Through the data, it is clear that the region includes an ample supply of skilled and unskilled labor that offers diverse backgrounds and contributions.

# Education & Training

Mitchell County has a well established labor talent pipeline. The Mitchell County labor force for whom educational attainment information is available is comprised of at least 80 percent high school graduates and above. The top three programs for recently awarded degrees and certificates within the 60 mile radius of Camilla are Healthcare; Business, Management, and Marketing; and Liberal Arts and Sciences. The top award levels recently granted within a 60 mile radius of Camilla are bachelor's degrees, certificates of less than one year, and associate's degrees. The total enrollment in higher education programs within a 60 mile radius of Camilla is 98,515 students. Additional data can be provided by ECG Office of Economic & Community Development regarding educational attainment level by industry and degrees and certificates awarded by program, school, or associated occupation.

Educational Attainment of Labor Force - Mitchell County\*\* (2017)

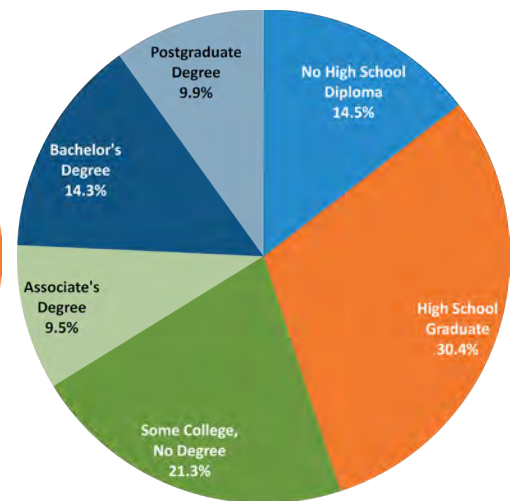
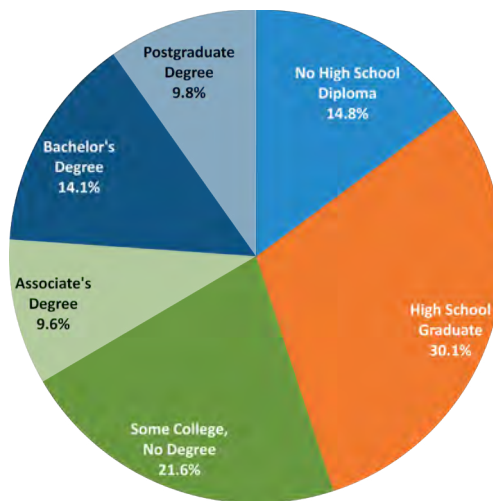
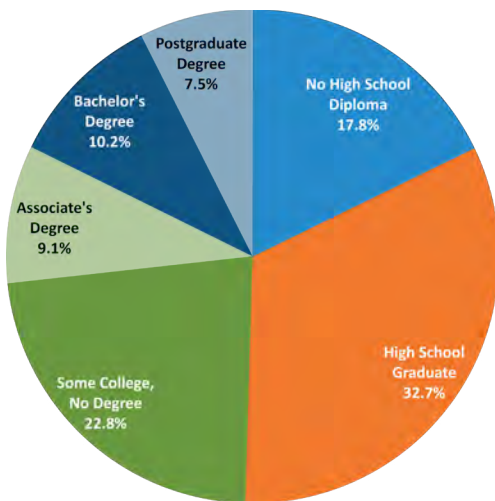


Educational Attainment of Population Aged 25-64 (2017)

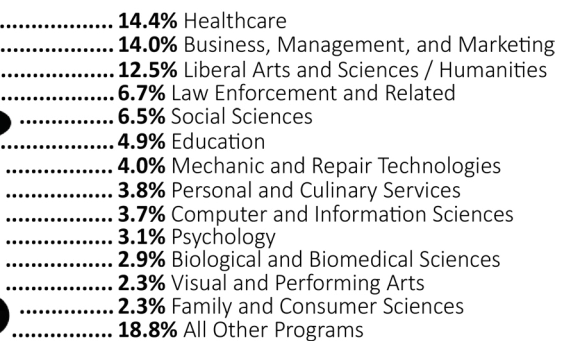
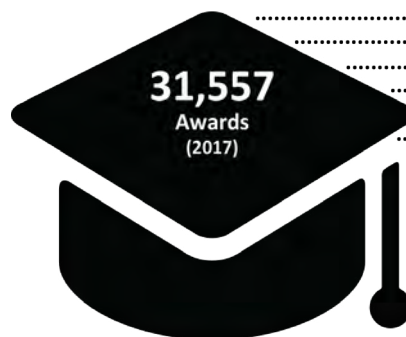
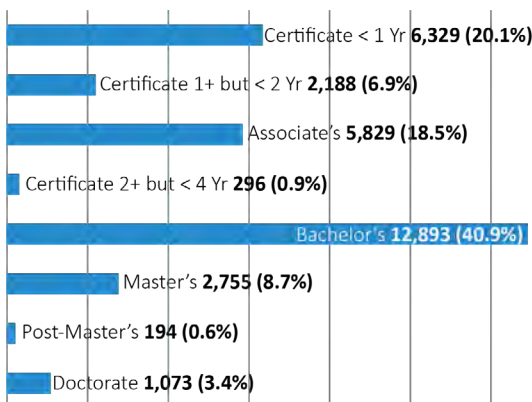
