Introduction Toccoa, Georgia

Nestled at the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains, Toccoa has a population of about 9,100 people. The heart of Toccoa is the Downtown District, also known as Main Street Toccoa.

Main Street Toccoa strives to create a downtown that houses a diverse selection of restaurant, retail, and professional businesses, all within an atmosphere that is safe, beautiful, and walkable.

- Located 90 miles Northeast of Atlanta and 60 miles South of Greenville.
- Toccoa is in Stephens County and the County Seat.

Revitalization




Downtown Mall The most significant economic development project is the removal of the covered mall.

Completed in 1970 with Urban Renewal funds, the mall suffered decline as businesses left to locate on the main highway corridor.

In 2007-08, the concrete covered canopies were removed and the street opened to vehicular traffic. Downtown was returned to its historic look.

Downtown Design Evolution






Doyle Street is the Main Street of Downtown

Impact of Mall Removal



- Retained and expanded 40 small businesses
- \$3.5 M private investment
- 15 FT new jobs, 29 PT new jobs
- 54 FT jobs, 35PT jobs retained
- Over 80% of properties attached to concrete covered walkways underwent building renovations
- Over 80 storefronts renovated since 2007








Toccoa Train Depot


Another important economic development project is the Historic Train Depot, which serves as home to:





Historic Ritz Theatre

Grants have funded:

- Conditions Assessment and Preservation Plan
- HVAC, life safety
- Restoration of original Art Deco Modern façade
- Marquee
- State-of-the-art sound system
- Balcony, Basement, and Plaza Upgrades



Ritz Theatre Renovations





1959

Fred T. McLendon built 36 theaters across Georgia. Of those only 2 remain, the Ritz and Buckhead Theatre.

1990s - 2014

The Ritz was "modernized" and renamed the Schaefer Center. It was owned by the Currahee Arts Council.



2014 - Today

The Arts Council deeded the Ritz to the City of Toccoa for \$1.

Historic Ritz Theatre

- Opened as a 500 seat single-screen movie theater.
- Became a performing arts venue, under the Currahee Arts Council.
- Installed a brick veneer over the stucco façade.
- Arts Council donated it to the City.
- Now on the National & Georgia Registers of Historic Places.
- 142 Events in 2022 with an 85% increase in attendance from 2021.
- New Addition will enhance the theater experience.



Entertainment District

Setting the Pulse for Our Community

- An overlay commonly found in the historic downtown or central business district
- Allows for certain privileges within the boundaries of the overlay
- Restaurants may sell alcoholic beverages in a clear, dated, plastic 16-oz cup
- Patrons may enjoy their beverage on public sidewalks and inside the storefronts of other businesses within the boundaries of the Entertainment District
- Utilized as a downtown development tool to encourage business recruitment, and retention
- Various regulations, commonly found in a city's alcohol ordinance, govern the safety of an **Entertainment District**






